The first recorded reference to “The Standing Goat” precedes Mil Harei’s Red Book by 167 years in a small collection known as the Urwen papers, for the town in which they were discovered. In that collection the tune is called “The Captain’s Chair.” Urwen lies along the western shore and this connection provides further evidence of the extent of Harei’s travels in the Hollish Isles.
